## Workshops set for recreation project

WILMINGTON - Two open houses will be held this month for Delawareans and Marylanders to learn more about and discuss a plan to develop more recreational opportunities along the Chesapeake & Delaware Canal.

Delaware Rep. Mike Castle first announced his plan to further develop the C&D Canal into a recreational site in spring 2004 and since then has secured \$150,000 in federal funding to start a study.

The Delaware Department of Transportation, Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control and New Castle County have pledged matching funds toward the study.

A group studying the proposal has recommended that a multi-use trail for walkers, joggers and bikers serve as the main element in all plans to enhance recreation along the canal.
