Will the Pond Creek project benefit fish and wildlife resources?

Yes. Here's why: A native salt marsh is more valuable to fish and wildlife than a non-native *Phragmites* freshwater marsh. By restoring Pond Creek to a native salt marsh, there will be an improvement in the quality of habitat. Among these improvements, will be increases in food, cover, and habitat diversity for birds, fish, shellfish, and reptiles.
