**DESCRIPTION:** This purpose of this project was to investigate multiple flood related issues pertaining to White Clay Creek, New Castle County, Delaware using the most recent or newly acquired topographic data. The project involved modeling and updating existing hydrologic and hydraulic analyses as necessary and revising the FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) when appropriate. The team investigated local issues, past studies, and other known problems and coordinated with local stakeholders.

**STATUS:** The project received sufficient funds in FY 2010 to complete this effort. The team studied in detail an eight-mile reach of White Clay Creek including additional analysis of several tributaries to White Clay Creek. The Corps and the Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Conservation are developing the final deliverables for this project. Completion is expected by the end of FY 2011.
