AUTHORITY: Section 204 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1992, as amended by Section 2037 of WRDA 2007.

LOCATION: Barnegat Inlet is a Federal Navigation Channel located between Barnegat Light, Long Beach Island and Island Beach State Park in Ocean County, NJ. The Inlet is actively used for commercial fishing vessels and is maintained by USACE semi-annually.

DESCRIPTION: The project will develop a regional sediment management (RSM) plan for Barnegat Inlet to identify and evaluate opportunities to beneficially use dredged material from the navigation channel for the most cost effective and hydraulically advantageous nearshore placement of sandy material in support of the Federal beachfill.

STATUS: FY10 funds were used to initiate the RSM study. FY 11 funds, subject to availability, would be used to continue the RSM effort.
