**BUSINESS PROGRAM:**  
Flood & Storm Damage Reduction

**AUTHORITY:** House Resolution, Committee on Public Works and Transportation, dated December 10, 1987 for the New Jersey Shoreline.

**LOCATION** The study area includes Five Mile Island, located on the Atlantic Coast of New Jersey between Hereford and Cape May Inlets.

**DESCRIPTION:** The study area was investigated as part of the New Jersey Shore Protection Reconnaissance Study completed in 1990. Since that time erosion has accelerated in North Wildwood, while accretion has continued along the central and southern portions of the island causing health, environmental and storm-water drainage problems. Problems being addressed by the study include:

- Erosion in North Wildwood
- Discontinuous dunes in North Wildwood, Wildwood, and Wildwood Crest
- Low, flat beaches of Wildwood and Wildwood Crest exposing property to damages
- Clogged storm water outfalls due to excessive beach width

**STATUS:** The Feasibility study is scheduled to be complete in 2009. Financial Data includes the projected amount from 2003 Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement, \$2,500,000.
