APPROPRIATION / PHASE:

Continuing Authorities / Design & Implementation

BUSINESS PROGRAM:

Flood Damage Reduction

AUTHORITY: Section 14 of the Flood Control Act of 1946, as amended: Emergency Stream Bank Stabilization.

LOCATION: The study area is Bergerville Road along the Manasquan River in Howell Township, Monmouth County, New Jersey.

DESCRIPTION: The project consists of proposed bank stabilization along approximately 250 feet of the right bank of the river parallel to Bergerville Road (aka Casino Drive) at a sharp curve in the river. The proposed wall would be constructed of 6 foot deep by 8-inch high confined cellular (CCS) grids stacked to a height of 11 feet. Toe protection to prevent undermining of the CCS retaining wall will be provided by an 18 inch deep by 20 foot wide leveling material and a CCS scour apron placed perpendicular to the wall.

STATUS: Full Federal funds for construction were received in FY07. FY08 activities included development of plans and coordination of the PCA. FY09 activities will include execution of the PCA, obtaining State environmental permits, real estate acquisition and award of a construction contract.
