Continuing Authorities / Feasibility

**BUSINESS PROGRAM:**  
Coastal Storm Damage Reduction

**AUTHORITY:** Section 103 of the River and Harbor Act of 1962, as amended (Hurricane and Storm Damage Reduction)

**LOCATION:** The study area is located on the backbay (west) side of Seaside Park, NJ, south of the State Route 37 bridge from the mainland.

**DESCRIPTION:** The study area is subject to erosion of the bayside beaches, which contributes to the larger problem of tidal flooding of streets and residences. The area was investigated in 1995 as a Section 103 CAP project, with a recommendation to proceed to a feasibility study. The feasibility study however was never initiated due to lack of sponsorship at that time.

**STATUS:** Funds in the amount of \$69.7K were received back in the early 1990s to complete a Reconnaissance Report dated 1995. Subsequent to this, no funds were received until FY09. Carryover FY09 funds were used to negotiate a Feasibility Cost Share Agreement (FCSA) with the non-Federal sponsor. NJDEP is expected to sign the FCSA in early 2011. FY11 funds, subject to availability, would be used to complete the feasibility study which would commence upon agreement execution.
