**LOCATION:** Pohopoco Creek, Lehigh River Basin

**DESCRIPTION:** The existing project adopted as HD 87 522 in 1962, provides for multiple purpose development for water supply, flood control and recreation. The project consists of an earth and rock filled dam; a spillway around the north end of the dam; and gate controlled outlet works discharging through a conduit on rock along the right abutment. The dam is located on Pohopoco Creek 4 1/2 miles from its confluence with the Lehigh River and 4 miles east of Lehighton, Pennsylvania. The project was completed in 1971.
