APPROPRIATION / PHASE:
Continuing Authorities / Feasibility

BUSINESS PROGRAM:
Flood Damage Reduction

AUTHORITY: Section 14 of the Flood Control Act of 1946, as amended: Emergency Stream Bank Stabilization.

LOCATION: The project is located along Brodhead Creek in Stroud Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania.

DESCRIPTION: Brodhead Creek Regional Authority is a public water provider serving 5 municipalities in Monroe County with over 5,200 billing accounts and an estimated population of 22,000. Its main facilities are located along Brodhead Creek. Major flooding events since January 1996 have eroded Authority property and now threaten Wells #1 and #2 which are permitted to provide up to 2.88 MGD of water to the system. The Authority has installed riprap in several locations to protect its facilities and now has a need to connect and extend that work along the west bank of the Brodhead Creek to protect against the threat of continued loss of its wellhead protection property.

STATUS: FY11 funds received to date will be used to initiate the feasibility study. Additional FY11 funds, subject to availability, would be used to complete the feasibility study, execute the Project Partnership Agreement (PPA) with the non-Federal sponsor, and initiate the plans and specs.
