LOCATION: Confluence of Bear Creek and Lehigh River

DESCRIPTION: The existing project, adopted as HD 79-587 in 1946, and modified by HD 87-522 in 1962, provides for multi-purpose development for water supply, recreation and flood control. The modified plan of improvement requires altering the spillway, increasing the height of the dam, extending the outlet tunnel, constructing new dikes and raising the height of existing dikes. The existing dam, completed under the 1946 Flood Control Act as a single purpose flood control project, is located on the Lehigh River, five miles above White Haven, Pa.

STATUS: The access road over the top of dam was completed in the spring of 2005.
