BUSINESS PROGRAM:
Flood Damage Reduction

AUTHORITY: Section 14 of the Flood Control Act of 1946, as amended: Emergency Stream Bank Stabilization.

LOCATION: The study area is River Road along the Schuylkill River in North Coventry Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania.

DESCRIPTION: The project consists of proposed bank stabilization along the right bank of the Schuylkill River parallel to River Road between Laurelwood Road and the Hanover Street Bridge. The site will be investigated and geotechnical analyses performed to determine the cause of the bank instability and propose an engineering solution. An analysis of alternatives and environmental assessment will also be required prior to any construction.

STATUS: FY07 funds were used to initiate a feasibility study. FY08 funds will be used to complete the feasibility study, including development of a recommended plan and an environmental assessment, obtaining environmental permits, and negotiation of the draft PCA.
