BUSINESS PROGRAM: Regional Sediment
Management, Ecological Restoration

AUTHORITY: Section 204 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1992, as modified by Section 2037 of WRDA 2007.

LOCATION: The Schuylkill River watershed is located in ten counties of southeastern Pennsylvania. The majority of the watershed is located in Schuylkill, Berks, and Montgomery Counties.

DESCRIPTION: The project will develop a regional sediment management (RSM) plan for the Schuylkill River watershed to identify and evaluate opportunities to beneficially use dredged material from existing Corps disposal sites to restore streams degraded by acid mine drainage from abandoned mines.

STATUS: FY10 funds were used to initiate the RSM study. FY11 funds, subject to availability, would be used to continue coordination and development of the RSM plan.
