The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Philadelphia District Regulatory Branch is updating its current Public Notice mailing list, as required by 33 CFR Part 325.3(d)(4), and will change established procedures for publication and distribution of Public Notices.

Beginning on May 1, 2006, the Philadelphia District Regulatory Branch will no longer mail paper copies of Public Notices, except on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of this office. Paper copies of Public Notices will continue to be furnished by postal mail to the Federal and State agencies (USFWS, USEPA, NMFS, USCG, PADEP, NJDEP, DNREC, and MDE), local government offices, applicants, and property owners adjacent to proposed projects.

Instead, Public Notices will be available on the Philadelphia District Regulatory Branch website at <http://www.nap.usace.army.mil/cenap-op/regulatory/public-notice.html>. An e-mail message with a link to the Public Notice page will be sent to the new Public Notice Notification E-Mail Distribution List (PN e-mail list) when Public Notices are issued.

Public Notice listings will identify State, County, Township, and type of work and will contain a link to the full Public Notice, which includes 8 1/2"x 11" plans. Special Public Notices will also be listed on the website and involve topics such as changes in regulations, policies, restricted areas, emergency permitting requirements, etc.

Individuals and organizations wishing to receive Corps Public Notices may subscribe to the PN e-mail list by submitting a completed "Request for Public Notice E-Mail Distribution List" (online registration form) located at <https://w3.nap.usace.army.mil/regulatory/subscribe.htm>. The information contained in the online registration form is required for subscription approval and will be used solely for recordkeeping of Public Notice distributions as required by 33 CFR Part 325.3(d)(4). Registration forms without the required information will not be processed. Individuals and organizations are responsible for providing correct e-mail addresses to ensure timely delivery and receipt of notifications. We will not verify the receipt of any e-mail notifications. Registration information may be modified at any time using the online registration form.

Individuals and organizations that are currently on our Public Notice postal mailing list must either submit a registration form for the new PN e-mail list or submit a request for addition to the revised postal mailing list.

Individuals or organizations seeking an exception to the electronic Public Notice e-mail notification must submit a completed "Request for Addition Public Notice Postal Mail Distribution List" (Enclosure 1) to this office, with a written explanation as to why paper copies are requested (such as no internet access). Registration forms without the required information or with illegible information will not be processed.

In addition, individuals or organizations that request paper copies must indicate the distribution list(s) on which they would like to be included. The postal distribution list choices are the following:
