**Agreement of the Baltimore, Philadelphia, and Pittsburgh Districts, Corps of Engineers, with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) to accept funds from a non-Federal agency**

Final Notice of an agreement to expedite and streamline programmatic and project specific authorizations related to state and Federal transportation projects in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

This notice is to inform the public that the Baltimore, Philadelphia, and Pittsburgh Districts, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers have entered an agreement with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) to accept funds from a non-Federal agency in accordance with Section 214 of the Water Resources Development Act and Section 600.1 and Section 600.2 of Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act; A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU). The purpose of the agreement is to expedite and streamline programmatic and project specific authorizations related to state and Federal transportation projects in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

This public notice described the operation of the agreement and legal authority. Comments received from PennDOT were resolved through development of the final agreement. The funding agreement may be viewed at:


