## Restoration Advisory Board

The Corps established a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) for the DuPont Chambers Works FUSRAP Project in March 2000. It consists of representatives from the community, the Corps of Engineers, EPA, New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), and DuPont. The board meets regularly to discuss the Corps' restoration efforts at the DuPont facility.

RAB meetings are open to the public and serve as a forum for community input on restoration issues related to the Manhattan Engineer District cleanup effort at the DuPont Chamber Works facility. 4. Review and evaluate technical documents and plans.
5. Recommend priorities among projects.
6. Identify applicable standards consistent with the Comprehensive Environmental Response.

**From the South** – Take I-95 South to I-295 North across the Delaware Memorial Bridge to New Jersey. Exit 1A– RT 49 East-Pennsville-Salem and make a right at the end of the ramp to the first traffic light and the hotel is on the right.

**From the North** – Take the New Jersey Turnpike or RT 295 South to Exit 1. From Philadelphia – Take I-95 South to Exit 4-RT 322 East-Commodore Barry Bridge to Exit 1A-RT 49 East-Pennsville-Salem. Make a right at the end of the ramp and go to the first traffic light and the hotel is on the right.

**From Atlantic City** – Follow signs to RT 40 West. Take 40 West all the way to the I-295 South entrance. Take Exit 1A-RT 49 East-Pennsville-Salem and make a right off the ramp. At the first light make another right.
