-BLUE MARSH LAKE-DAY USE AREA BEACH REGULATIONS

BEACH AREA: The area from the bathhouse / concession stand to the swim area markers, and buoyed area.

- Swimming is at your own risk Diving is not permitted. LIFEGUARDS ARE NOT ON DUTY.
- 2. For your safety, please remain inside the NO BOAT ZONE designated by the white buoys. The ORANGE FLOATS designate the shallow zone; depths beyond this zone range from 5 feet to 35 feet. Depths may vary depending on flood-risk management and augmentation releases.
- 3. Floats, depth markers, and buoys are NOT to be used as support devices.
- 4. ONLY U.S. COAST GUARD APPROVED FLOTATION DEVICES ARE ALLOWED. INFLATABLE OBJECTS ARE PROHIBITED IN THE LAKE, including inner tubes, air mattresses, beach balls, and water wings. Frisbees, balls and other throwable objects are prohibited in the beach area.
- 5. PETS are to be kept out of the bathhouse, concessions, and beach areas.
- 6. Picnic tables, grills and glass containers are NOT allowed within the beach area.
