Park Rangers provide support for the preservation of these natural resources by managing recreational grounds, educating visitors through environmental outreach programs and enforcement of rules and regulations.

Typical Work Day

Park Rangers are often the first point of contact for park visitors. Rangers can expect to answer various questions about the park; explain rules and regulations; patrol the park project area; assist with traffic control and emergency responses; issue citations; and participate in water safety outreach initiatives.

In addition to visitor assistance, Seasonal Park Rangers can expect to perform a variety of other duties including interpretive services, natural resource management, and trail maintenance.



About Blue Marsh Lake

Blue Marsh Lake is a multi-purpose project located northwest of Reading, PA providing flood risk management, water supply, water quality, and recreation resources with 6200 acres of land and 1148 acres of water.

While the main purpose of Blue Marsh is to provide flood control to part of the Schuylkill River Valley, over the years the lake has become a recreational hotspot with over 36 miles of trails, picnic areas, a small beach and boat launches the lake can accommodate all kinds of outdoor enthusiasts. There are numerous opportunities to hike, bike, hunt, fish, and enjoy nature with family and friends.

Position Requirements

- Course work in natural resource management, park management, criminal justice, public administration, sociology, natural sciences, biological sciences, forestry, geosciences, or related fields.
