Who Needs a Permit: Special event permits are required for but are not limited to; boat regattas, fishing tournaments, festivals, presentations or other special recreation programs. These are events that are directed by any organization, group, school or church. The permit is free; however it does not exempt the group from following all project regulations and paying appropriate user fees. This process allows project staff to direct such activities and avoid user conflicts.

Instructions: Permits must be requested thirty (30) days in advance. Fill out all lines completely. **Use a separate sheet for each date requested.** Please provide a description of your event, or any additional information related to the event on page 2 of this application. Events taking place on the lake must have a permit from the PA Fish and Boat Commission.
