Explanation of Significant Differences for the Record of Decision for the Former DuPont Chambers Works FUSRAP Site

Notice is hereby given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Philadelphia District has released a report titled “Explanation of Significant Differences for the Record of Decision for the Former DuPont Chambers Works FUSRAP Site” regarding ongoing environmental remediation in Salem County, N.J. under the Formerly Used Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP).

The document provides an Explanation of Significant Differences (ESD) relative to the FUSRAP remedy, as presented in the 2013 Record of Decision (ROD), currently in progress at the Former DuPont Chambers Works Site (Chambers Works) in Deepwater, Salem County, New Jersey (Site). The selected FUSRAP remedial action for the Site includes excavation and off-site disposal of impacted soils at several areas of concern.

As part of the remedy implementation, additional areas of FUSRAP eligible impacts have been identified which present changes to the scope of work described in the 2013 ROD. The ESD report describes these changes and the proposed approach for addressing them as part of the ongoing FUSRAP remedy. The remedy selected in the 2013 ROD remains fundamentally unaltered, and the statutory determinations made in the ROD still apply.

A notice of availability and a summary of this ESD report will be published in a local major newspaper in accordance with 40 C.F.R. 300.435(c)(2)(i)(B). USACE will further utilize additional means of notification to the public such as inclusion of this ESD on the project website and ensuring hard copies are available at the Pennsville Library.
