When temperatures fluctuate, a lake's ice sheet will expand and contract, causing the ice to buckle under stress and push onto the shoreline. This process, known as an "ice shove," can be seen along the shorelines of all the Northern Area's reservoirs.

This clear blue ice, seen during a plane ride over Blue Marsh Lake during the winter of 2025, is considered to be the strongest type of ice. White ice, which is formed from frozen snow or slush, is only about half as strong as clear ice. Ice thickness is not monitored at the Northern Area reservoirs and caution should be taken by visitors when venturing out on the ice. Wearing a life jacket when exploring lake ice can help reduce the risk of drowning from cold water shock.

With flowers that resemble upside-down grape bunches, grape hyacinths are not a true hyacinth despite their name. They are among the earliest ephemeral flowers to bloom during the spring season.

Known as “spring ephemerals,” trout lilies complete most of their life cycle in early spring before overhead tree canopies block out sunlight from the forest floor. Their mottle leaves resemble markings on brook trout, giving them their common name. From March through May, check out the forested sections of Blue Marsh Lake’s 50+ miles of trails to spot these short-lived blooms.

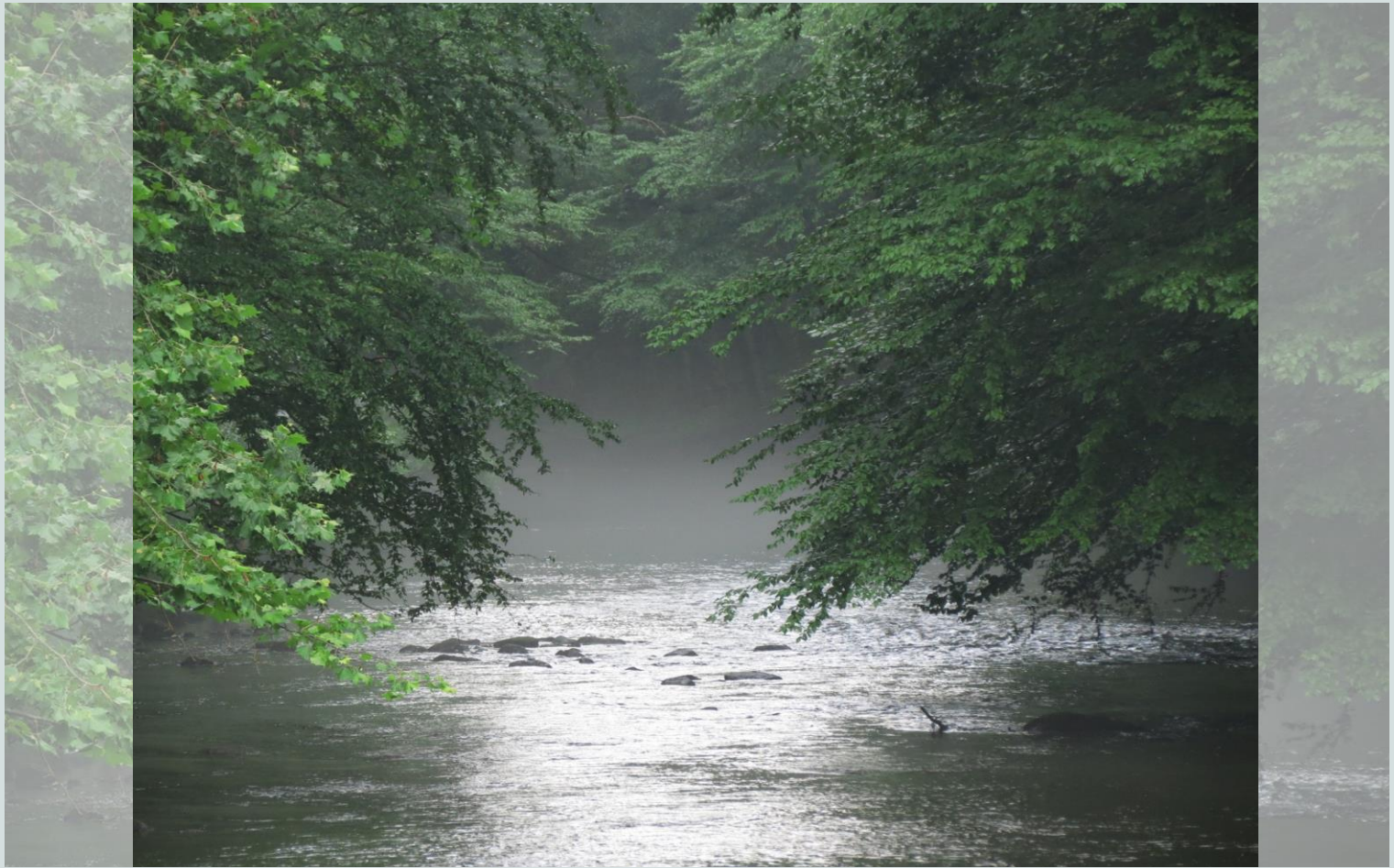

The West Branch Lackawaxen River flows 21.5 miles into the reservoir created by Prompton Dam. The dam captures water from a 59.7 square mile drainage area. Since 1960, Prompton Dam has prevented more than \$42.5 million in flooding damages.

Beltzville Lake, a 949-acre body of water with 19.8 miles of shoreline, was constructed in 1971-1972 primarily for flood control, water supply, and recreational use. Sunset viewing is a popular recreational activity, only to be enhanced by the reflections seen on the reservoirs surface.

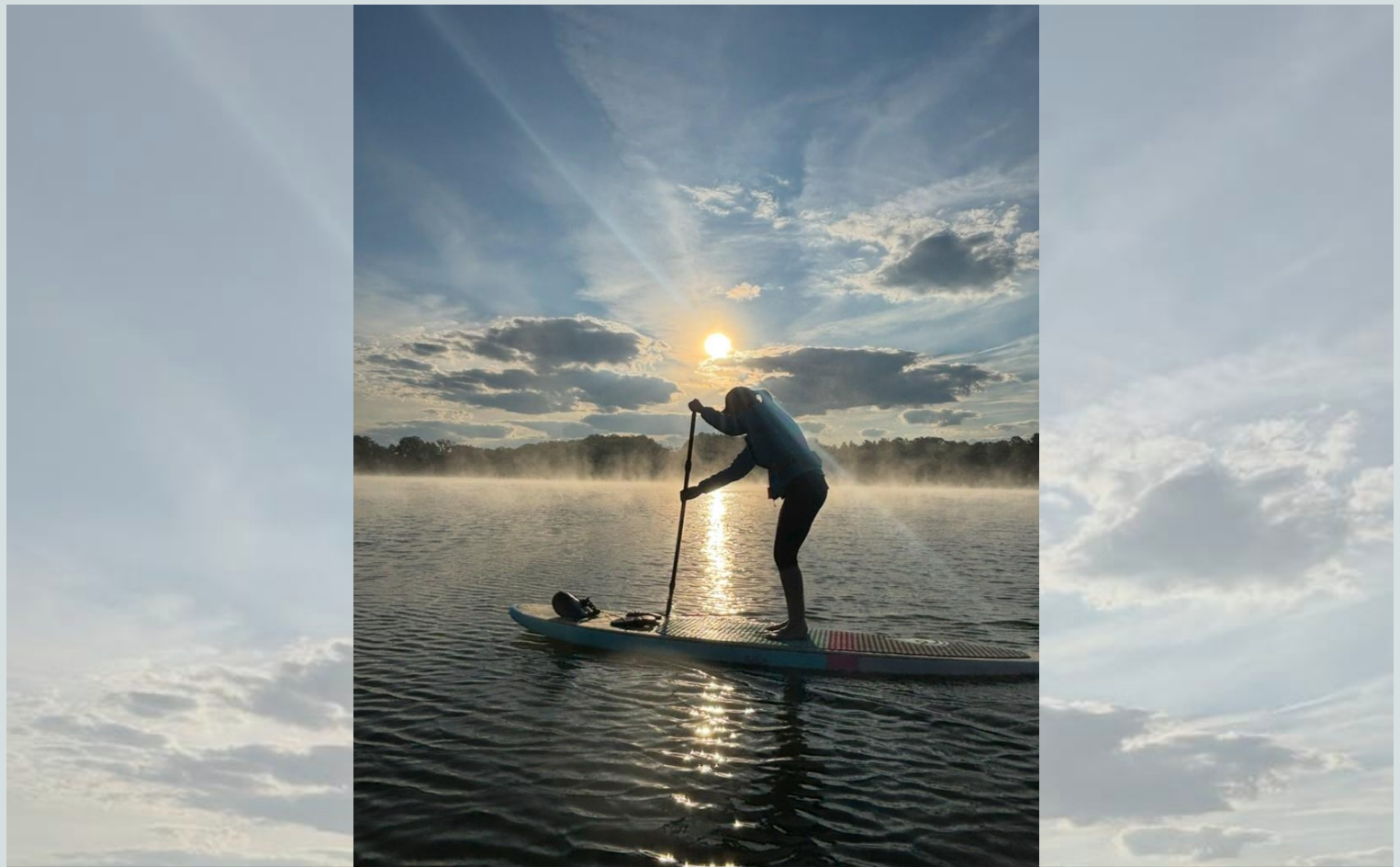

Sunsets appear red and orange due to a phenomenon called “Rayleigh scattering.” As sunlight passes through the Earth’s atmosphere, shorter wavelengths of light (like blue and violet) are scattered more efficiently by air molecules, leaving the longer wavelengths (red and orange) to reach our eyes. The view from the Blue Marsh Lake Visitor Center is a popular sunset viewing spot.

Turkey and black vultures are masters of the air, able to soar for hours on rising thermal air currents and updrafts with minimal flapping of their wings. They are frequently seen at their favorite soaring spot within the updrafts, along the upstream face of the Blue Marsh Lake Dam.

The Harrity Covered Bridge, also known as the "Buck" covered bridge, located in Beltzville State Park, was originally built in 1841 to cross Pohopoco Creek. When the creek was dammed in 1970 to create Beltzville Lake, the bridge was dismantled and reconstructed on dry land within the state park, where it now serves as a pedestrian bridge.
