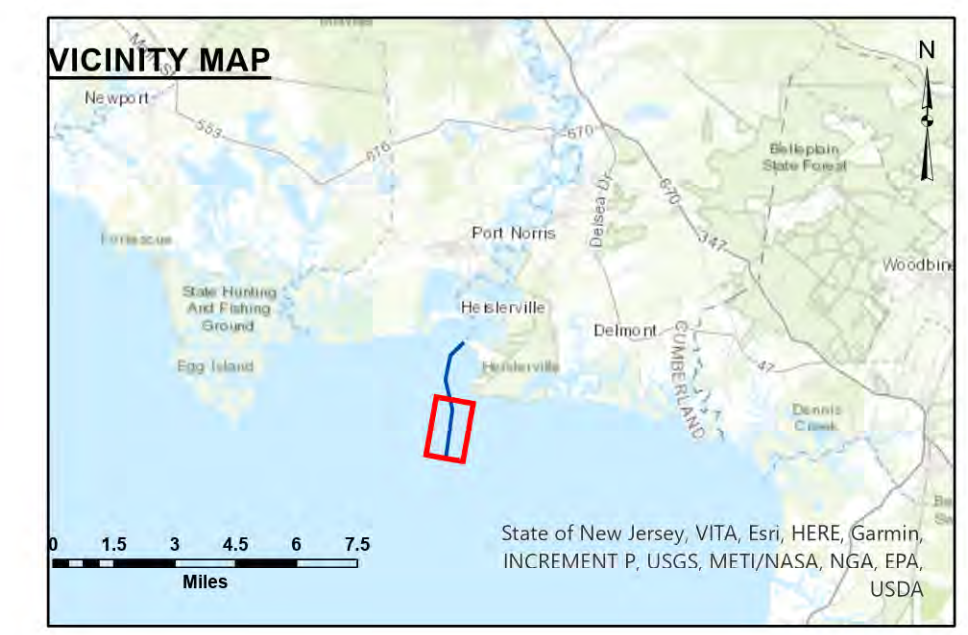
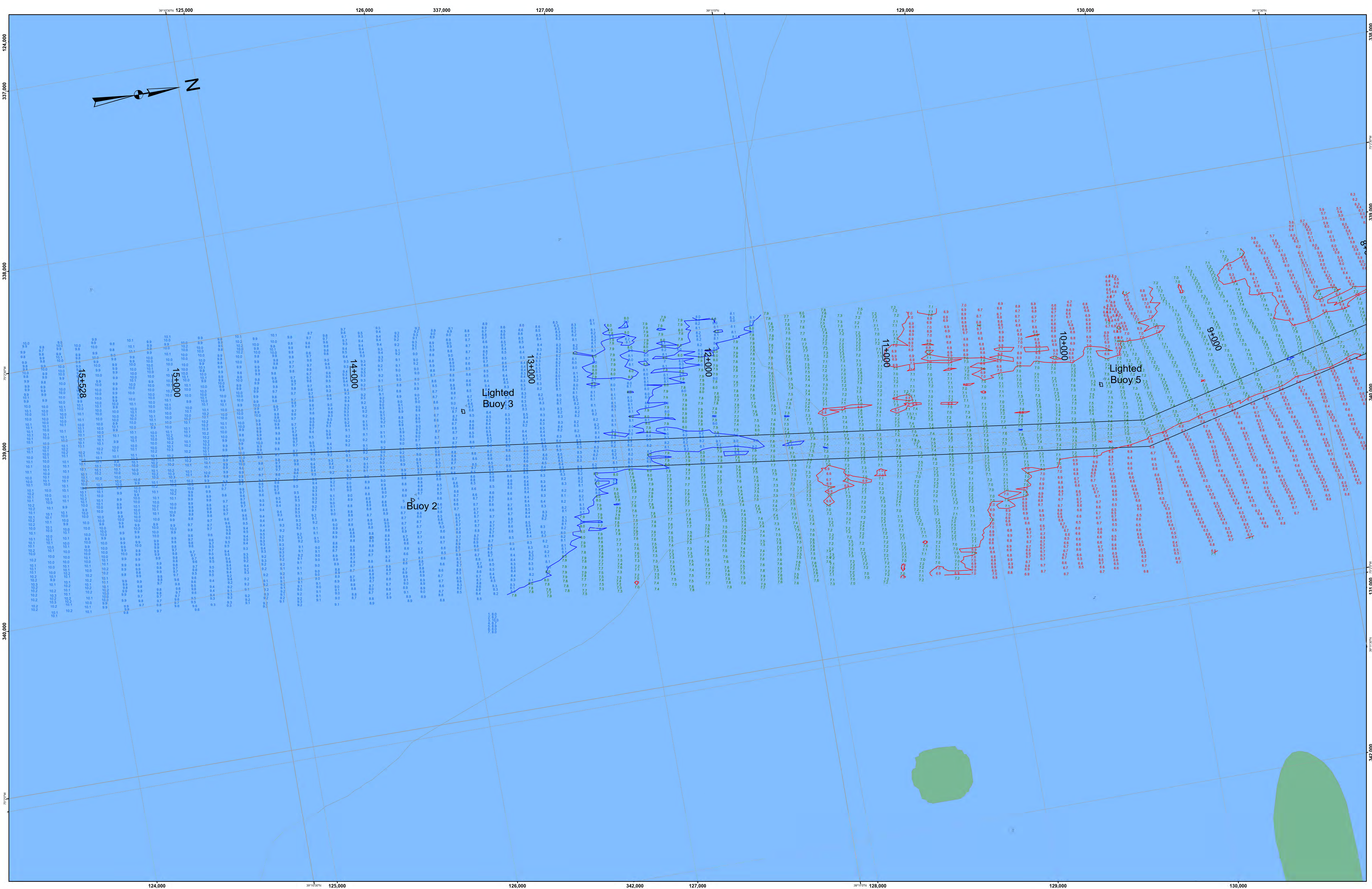
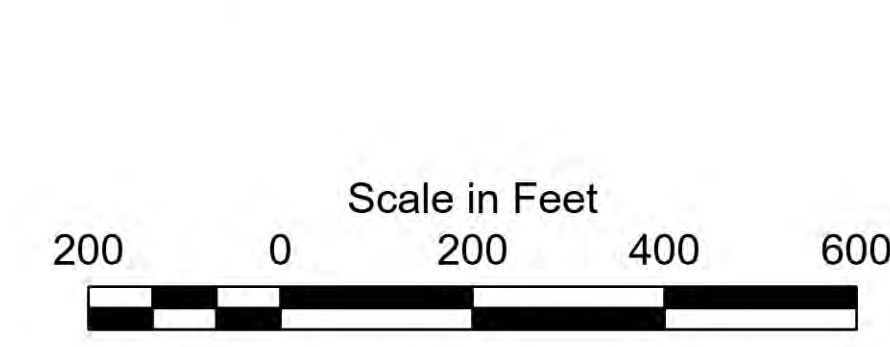




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2. HORIZONTAL REFERENCE - NAD 83, NEW JERSEY STATE PLANE, ZONE 2900, U.S. FOOT.
